Students of Grade 8 to A levels entered the world of human centred design on December 8th for an exclusive one-hour workshop with Ms. Ashna Saraf, the visionary founder of Created and a distinguished Harvard University graduate with a Masters in Educational Technology. A true advocate of the maker ideology, Ms. Ashna is passionate about empowering learners to become architects of change, designing innovative solutions for the challenges of tomorrow. Having earned recognition as the youngest winner of the Schmidt Futures Tools Competition and a recipient of the Harvard Education Entrepreneurship Fellowship, Ms. Ashna brings a wealth of knowledge and experience to the table.

During this transformative session, Ms. Ashna delved into the principles of human-centred design, guiding participants through the intricacies of root cause analysis, the powerful 5 Whys technique, and the nuances of urban planning. Students challenged their perspectives by questioning assumptions and learning the art of emotional influence in design thinking.

This workshop proved to be an immersive experience, equipping students with valuable insights and practical tools to elevate their problemsolving skills. Students engaged with one of the brightest minds in education and innovation.
