






### Sr Kg Inquiry Fair

## **Academic Activities**

Nursery

#### Area of Inquiry

In our Area of Inquiry on "All about Me" students further learnt about the importance of family members, their role in our life. They also learnt about self-awareness, daily routine and hygiene. We began with our 2nd inquiry on "Animal Kingdom" and students are having fun learning about different animals that they see around them through stories, games and group activities.

#### Numeracy

Our little learners had fun counting numbers 1-30 aloud with their friends and are now learning to begin with counting numbers up to 60. Students revised all the numbers done from 1-4 through worksheets, games and counting objects. Students were encouraged to count fans, lights, AC"s windows and crayons kept in a tray as simple everyday tasks.

For our little learners understanding the concept of tall and short is an important part of our development, as it helps them develop spatial awareness and the ability to make comparisons. Students learnt the difference between tall and short through sorting manipulative followed by colouring tall and short pictures in the worksheet.

#### Literacy

Recap of the letters learnt was done through group activities which helped students identify letters, say the sound, and identify the pictures that are related with the beginning sound of the letters. This was done with a follow-up up activity of sticking pictures related to the letters.


#### Hindi Diwas

#### ATLAS UNIVERSITY VISIT

The students of Grades 9, 10, AS, and A Levels visited the ATLAS SkillTech University on 18 September, 2023. The students interacted with Dr. Indu Shahani, the founding Dean of the Indian School of Management & Entrepreneurship (ISME ) at the University. The visit began with a tour of the campus wherein students got a live glimpse of the classrooms being conducted in the Fashion and Product Designing Department. Ms. Bulbul Chaudhary, the Pro Vice Chancellor of the University inducted the students into the Futuristic skills pertaining to Management, Design, and Technology. Students were introduced to 3 courses: ISDI (School of Design and Innovation), ISME (School of Management and Entrepreneurship), and uGDX (School of Technology). The Students also attended a workshop which was segregated into sessions concerning Business and Design. Students were also briefed about the ATLAS ISDI Summer School Program which stimulates them to think out-of-the-box and challenge them to find tangible solutions to problems.















#### Academic Activities: Science activity - Grade 6


Students of Grade 6 visited Physics lab to try their hands on experience and performed experiments on Centripetal force and gravity. It was a great learning experience for them.
