100% results secured by our IGCSE Class of 2025.


Veer Savla secured the First position with 91%-(4A* and 1A)

Our A Level students also earned accolades with Samarth Goyal securing 90% (3 A* and 1 A) and Ayushmaan Goyal securing 88% (3A*)










WELL ROUNDED EDUCATION


Numeracy: Students are exploring tens and ones through fun, interactive activities. Using their hands to represent numbers helps them understand place value in an enjoyable and meaningful way.
