4. **Clay Modelling:** Primary: Theme: **Save Animals**: **Third Prize**.

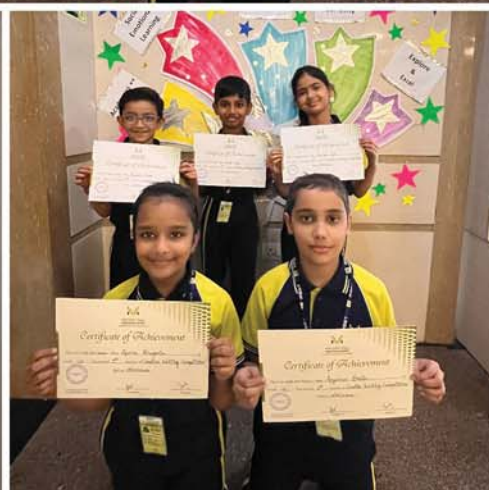
